THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that Article II, Section 3.B's granting member access "to all administrative and financial reports and records" applies to institutional documents such as financial statements and audits, not to individual flight attendant/members' financial or other records, including dues histories; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that members do not have the right under the Constitution to access financial or other records, including dues histories, of other flight attendants/members'; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that while APFA staff in the Membership and Dues Departments and APFA Representatives may continue to access flight attendant/members' records for APFA business reasons, APFA shall continue to honor members' right to individual privacy under Article II, Section 3.C.
