**WHEREAS**, per Section 12.H.2 of the APFA Policy Manual, the National Communications Coordinator will assist the President in the preparation and dissemination of any statements or publications, and this shall include press releases; and

**WHEREAS**, the APFA Board of Directors wishes to establish a procedure for the approval of press releases in order to ensure compliance with the foregoing.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that Section 12.H.2.of the APFA Policy Manual be amended as follows:

"All official statements made to the public/press by representatives of the APFA in their official capacity must reflect the official position of the APFA and the text of any written statements, press releases, etc., must be approved by the APFA President or, in the absence of the President, another National Officer.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this change shall take effect immediately.
