WHEREAS, four APFA American Airlines Flight Attendants were working crewmembers on board Flight #1420, and despite injuries and adverse conditions exhibited incredible acts of courage and struggle to save lives in the evacuation of the aircraft; and

WHEREAS, the APFA Board of Directors believes these acts deserve honor and recognition.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, that the APFA Board of Directors awards the Union's highest honor for safety, the Jose Chiu Award to Flight Attendant Nancy Luna, Flight Attendant Tammy Gardner, Flight Attendant Jennifer Chapman-Buck and Flight Attendant Laurie Nelson for their selfless acts of valor and bravery.
