**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that Section 12.D.1 of the APFA Policy Manual be amended to read:

- 1. The APFA may establish a toll-free recorded "HotLine" message tape for the benefit and information of flight attendants.
- 2. Any HotLine text and recording will be the responsibility of the Communications Coordinator, except as otherwise provided in this Policy Manual.
- 3. The HotLine may provide an update of APFA and industry news.
- 4. Balloting results may be announced on the HotLine by the APFA Secretary or his/her designee, who should be a member of the National Balloting Committee (NBC), as soon as the information becomes available.
- 5. With the exception of the balloting results, any HotLine text must be approved by a majority of the National Officers prior to recording.
