WHEREAS, Article XI, Section 1.A of the APFA Constitution provides that: "A proposed Collective Bargaining Agreement will be submitted to the affected membership for approval only after it has been accepted by a majority vote of the Negotiating Committee and presented to the Executive Committee", and

WHEREAS, Article IX, Sections 1.A. (1) and (2) of the APFA Constitution provides that the Board of Directors may override an Executive Committee rejection of a proposed Collective Bargaining Agreement and decide to submit the agreement to the membership for approval; and

WHEREAS, Article III, Section 3.L. (22) of the APFA Constitution provides that the Board of Directors has "the right to reverse an action or decision of the Executive Committee..."; and

WHEREAS, under Article III, Section 3.L(2) of the APFA Constitution, the APFA Board of Directors has the responsibility of reviewing, and if necessary, modifying the APFA Policy Manual;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that a new Section 18 be added to the APFA Policy Manual to read as follows:

SECTION 18 PROPOSED COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENTS

A. PRESENTATION TO THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

The APFA Board of Directors will be invited to attend the presentation of a proposed Collective Bargaining Agreement by the Negotiating Committee to the Executive Committee.

B. BOARD OF DIRECTOR INPUT

Prior to deciding whether to send p proposed Collective Bargaining Agreement to the membership for ratification, the Executive Committee shall seek input from the Board of Directors members who attend the presentation of a Proposed Collective Bargaining Agreement

C. REJECTION BY THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

In accordance with Article XI, Sections 1.A(1) and (2) of the APFA Constitution, if the Executive Committee rejects a proposed agreement, the Negotiating Committee shall present the proposed agreement to the Board of Directors and the Board may decide to submit the proposed agreement to the membership for approval.
