WHEREAS, during the first hours on December 23, 2009, APFA GO TEAM Members, Lonny Glover and Tim Lessa received the call from the APFA National Safety & Security Coordinator, Kelly Skyles, and without hesitation or question and willing to forgo their entire holiday plans with their loved ones, accepted their call to duty as GO TEAM Members and along with Kelly Skyles, deployed to KIN to participate in the accident investigation of AA flight #331, which lasted until the beginning of the New Year; and

WHEREAS, the dedication and accomplishments of these fifteen representatives have brought a great deal of respect to the APFA; and

WHEREAS, the level of professionalism, selfless actions and care provided have represented what is the “*Best of the Best*” of our membership and the entire Flight Attendant workforce industry wide.
