**WHEREAS**, the APFA Policy Manual provides both incoming and outgoing Chairs and Division Representatives a transition period; and

WHEREAS, only the outgoing Coordinators are allotted transition; and

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**WHEREAS**, it is in the membership's best interest to have a trained Coordinator(s) upon assuming their appointment.

**BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED**, that the following changes be incorporated to the APFA Policy Manual.

Section 9.C.4.b.

(1) At the end of a term or consecutive terms, Base Chairs shall be provided with a five (5) day transition period.

Section 13.B.1.g

- 4. Transition for Coordinator(s)
  - a. Transition for Incoming Coordinators)
    - (1) Following the Executive Committee's confirmation and prior to the effective date of the appointment, incoming Coordinator(s) shall be granted trip removal in accordance with Section 5 of this Policy Manual, so as to ensure a transition period for training. The transition period shall begin on a time and date determined by the President. In no case shall this transition be less than seven (7) days prior to the effective date of the appointment.
  - b. Transition for Outgoing Coordinator(s)
    - (1) At the end of a term or consecutive terms, Coordinator(s) shall be provided with a ten (10) day transition period.
      - (a) This transition period is not consider as a benefit of every term and shall be offered only at the conclusion of a term or consecutive term(s), after which the outgoing Coordinator(s) shall be relinquishing all duties and responsibilities of the position.
      - (b) This transition period shall be paid in accordance with Section 5 of this Policy Manual and shall be funded from the affected budget.
      - (c) The outgoing Coordinator(s) may be called upon during the transition period to assist the incoming Coordinator(s).

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## Section 13.C.1

- a. Transition for Incoming Division Representatives
  - (1) Following the Executive Committee's confirmation and prior to the effective date of the appointment, incoming Division Representatives shall be granted trip removal in accordance with Section 5 of this Policy Manual, so as to ensure a transition period for training. The transition period shall begin on a time and date determined by the Vice President. In no case shall this transition period be less than seven (7) days prior to the effective date of the appointment period.
