WHEREAS, Article IV, Section 3.A of the Constitution provides that: "Required dues, assessments and initiation fee(s) not paid within sixty (60) days of the established billing date will cause a member to be placed in bad standing;" and

**WHEREAS,** in numerous sections, the Constitution provides that in order to run for or be appointed to APFA officer and representative positions, a member must be in good standing; and

**WHEREAS,** it is implicit in the Constitution that a member must remain in good standing in order to continue to hold the officer or representative position;

**BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED,** that the Board of Directors hereby interprets the APFA Constitution to require that as a condition of continuing to hold an APFA position, an elected or appointed officer or representative must remain in good standing; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED,** that immediately upon becoming a member in bad standing, an elected or appointed officer or representative shall be ineligible to continue to hold, and shall be removed from his or her position.
