WHEREAS, under Article II, Section 3.A of the APFA Constitution, the Board of Directors is authorized to interpret the Consitution and "to establish, prescribe and dopt such other policies which may be consistent with this Constituion as required for the direction and management of the affairs of the APFA;" and

WHEREAS, Article III.3.I(4)(a) of the Constitution provides, in part, that, in the event that a Base Chair cannot attend all or part of a Board of Directors meeting, the Vice Chair shall attend in his/her absence:

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, that Section 4.A.3.a of the APFA Policy Manual be amended to read:

- (1) If a Base Chair is absent at the beginning of a Board of Directors meeting or Convention ("meeting"), the Vice Chair shall represent the base in the Base Chair's absence. (If the Vice Chair is not available, the Base Chair may designate a Base Council or base member in accordance with Article III.I(4)(a) of the Constitution ["other designated representative"]). If the Base Chair arrives at the meeting during that business day, he/she shall assume representation of the base.
- (2) If a Base Chair is present at the beginning of a meeting and leaves during any day of the meeting, he/she shall be entitle to either:
 - a. Issue his/her proxy in accordance with Article III.I(2) of the APFA Constitution; or
 - b. Designate the Vice Chair (or other designated representative) to represent the base for the rest of the business day.
- (3) If a Base chair designates the Vice Chair (or other representative) under paragraph (2) above and does not return to the meeting the following business day, the Vice Chair shall represent the base for that day and any following days unless and until the Base Chair returns.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the following changes be made to Section 4.A.3.b(1)(b) of the APFA Policy Manual:

Delete subsection (a);

Reword the introductory paragraph of subsection (b) to read: "A Base Chair in attendance at a meeting shall represent the base in accordance with Section 4.A.3(a), except that:"

Amend subsection (c) to read: "A Vice Chair or an other designated representative at a meeting ..."
