WHEREAS, the Tarrant County (Texas) Central Labor Council AFL-CIO (hereinafter referred to as TCCLC) has among its objectives "to secure united action of all branches of organized labor affiliated with the AFL-CIO within its jurisdiction and through united action to protect, maintain and advance the interest of all working people in its territory . . [and] to increase public understanding of the labor movement;" and

WHEREAS, historically the TCCLC's membership has included only members of AFL-CIO-affiliated unions, in these difficult times for workers and working families it has reached out to APFA to see if APFA would be interested in pledging 500 members. Such a pledge would

entitle APFA to five delegates to the TCCLC's Labor Council and a seat on the TCCLC Executive Board; and

WHEREAS, the cost to APFA will be minimal (currently \$0.35 per member); and

WHEREAS, APFA believes in labor solidarity; and

WHEREAS, it is in APFA's interest to see if benefits will result from having members in the TCCLC;

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, that APFA pledge 500 members to the Tarrant County Central Labor Council AFL-CIO; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the National Officers are authorized to cease these memberships if they conclude that continued membership is not worthwhile.
