**WHEREAS,** Article III, Section 3.L.(1) and (2) of the APFA Constitution authorizes the Board of Directors to set policy for the APFA and to review, if necessary, modify the APFA Policy Manual; and

**WHEREAS**, the flight attendants of American Airlines have been working on the line under adverse conditions since the ratification of the Restructuring Participation Agreement in 2003.

## **BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED**, Section 5.C.1.a. shall be amended to read:

Any member in good standing may be removed from flight assignment(s) to participate in the affairs of the APFA, subject to the provisions herein.

(1) Such members requiring trip removal from flight assignment are encouraged to fly and should attempt to fly a minimum of one (1) trip every rolling six (6) month period.
