WHEREAS, it is always in the best interest of the APFA to avoid the potential of perceived or actual improprieties and conflicts of interests in all aspects of business;

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, Section 7.E. of the APFA Policy Manual be amended to include:

2. It is also in the best interest of the APFA to avoid the potential of perceived or actual improprieties and conflicts of interests between APFA Representatives and his/her spouse, domestic partner, family member. Under no circumstances shall any representative, in this position, provide sole approval for any APFA financial expenses.
