WHEREAS, the Company's Term Sheet proposes changes to Articles in the AA/APFA CBA relating to Flight Attendant seniority accrual; and

WHEREAS, active Flight Attendants are negatively affected by the company's proposed Term Sheet; and

WHEREAS, the Company's proposed Term Sheet does not affect Flight Attendants who transfer to a non-flying status or supervisory duty, per Article 17.C;

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, that if there are going to be changes to Flight Attendants' seniority accrual with regards to active flying, the Board strongly encourages the Negotiating Team to seek like provisions for Flight Attendants who transfer to non-flying or supervisory duties.
