WHEREAS, the APFA is an institution that collects dues money from its members primarily if not solely for the purpose of conducting operations commensurate with representing their professional interests; and

WHEREAS, in concert with the above, it is then reasonable to conclude that elected officials of the APFA are to act solely in a manner that defends, safeguards, or preferably enhances the

professional interests of APFA and its members; and

WHEREAS, APFA General Counsel is present at every Board of Directors meeting for advice and counsel regarding any contemplated actions of the Association; and

WHEREAS, it is a high priority of responsibility for elected officials of the APFA to safeguard Association finances, as well as protect it from legal harm, in a manner that no resource would be improperly allocated, abused, or utilized frivolously; and

WHEREAS, the cost of rerunning an election or representing the Association in a lawsuit can be quite significant, so much so that the Association could be left in the untenable situation of not having ample resources to competently represent the professional interests for which it is primarily charged;

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, that if any representative of the APFA willfully disregards the advice of counsel and engages in any action that results in financial harm to the APFA, that member may be held financially responsible for related costs incurred by the APFA necessary to protect itself.
