BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, that the Fall 2012 Board Training be Robert's Rules of Order training; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that is strongly suggested that the next 4 Board of Directors meetings have the presence of a Parliamentarian to ensure that Robert's Rules of Order are used correctly
