WHEREAS, AMR Corporation filed for Chapter 11 Bankruptcy on November 29, 2012; and

WHEREAS, in the bankruptcy proceeding, on February 1, 2012 American Airlines presented APFA with a Business Plan and with a Term Sheet proposing sweeping changes to our contract; and

WHEREAS, APFA is not persuaded that AMR has created a viable Business plan; and

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WHEREAS, the Term Sheet, if implemented, would decimate our Collective Bargaining Agreement; and

WHEREAS, APFA is facing the greatest challenge of our 35 year history; and

WHEREAS, the APFA Board of Directors, the current and incoming APFA National Officers and Ad Hoc Members of the Executive Committee, and the Base Vice Chairpersons agree that it is imperative that all APFA leadership work together to protect our members;

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, that the APFA Board of Directors, the current and incoming APFA National Officers and Ad Hoc Members of the Executive Committee, and the Base Vice Chairpersons stand together, shoulder to shoulder, in solidarity and with resolute determination to work to safeguard and protect the wages, benefits, working conditions and careers of the American Airlines Flight Attendant.
