WHEREAS, the Association of Flight Attendants (AFA) represents the pre-merger US Airways Flight Attendants; and,

WHEREAS, AFA and APFA agree that protecting and promoting the interests of the Flight Attendants at the new American is the paramount goal of both unions; and

WHEREAS, our two Flight Attendant unions agree that working in unity is the best path forward at the new American; and

WHEREAS, APFA and AFA both are committed to achieving an industry-leading contract for all the Flight Attendants at the new American are standing together to utilize the leverage of both the US Airways and American Airlines collective bargaining agreements in order to achieve an industry-leading contract at the New American; and

WHEREAS, to accomplish these goals, AFA and APFA forged the AFA/APFA Agreement on Bargaining and Representation that is attached to this resolution;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the APFA Board of Directors approves the December 18, 2013 AFA/APFA Agreement on Bargaining and Representation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that APFA enthusiastically looks forward to welcoming the pre-merger US Airways Flight Attendants and looks forward to working together to build the great future we all deserve.
