**WHEREAS**, Articles III Section 6.B.(10) of the APFA Constitution authorizes the National President to hire, retain or employ general counsel and/or other legal counsel for the APFA; and

**WHEREAS**, Articles III Section 6.C.(7) of the APFA Constitution authorizes the National Vice-President to hire, retain and employ legal counsel as may be required to provide members with representation in the grievance and arbitration process; and **WHEREAS**, Article III Section 3.A of the APFA Constitution authorizes the Board of Directors to interpret this constitution and to establish policy for the APFA; and

**WHEREAS**, the APFA Constitution is silent on the right of the Board of Directors to request a second legal opinion; and

**WHEREAS**, in order to safeguard and/or protect the APFA and its members it may be in the best interest of the Board of Directors to request a second legal opinion.

**BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED**, that Section 4.A.8.b be added to Section 4.A.8 of the APFA Policy Manual.

b. A majority vote by the Board of Directors will be required to request the National President to seek a second legal opinion in order to safeguard and/or protect the APFA and its members.
