WHEREAS, base presidents and vice presidents are the primary source for flight attendants to direct

questions and/or concerns regarding "Hotline" content.

**WHEREAS,** "HOTLINE" text is frequently emailed to the base presidents and vice presidents minutes before the "HOTLINE" is electronically distributed to the Flight Attendants, which inhibits base leadership from being able to clarify the "HOTLINE" content and/or address concerns.

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED,** that Section 12.D. of the APFA policy manual is updated to add line 7.

## Addition 12.D.7 to read:

With the exception of the balloting results, "HOTLINE" text must be emailed to the base presidents and vice presidents APFA email accounts prior to the electronically-distributed "HOTLINE" message to the Flight Attendants.
