**WHEREAS,** Article III, Section 2.A. of the APFA Constitution provides that the governmental powers of the APFA shall be vested in the Board of Directors and the Officers and Representatives of the APFA in accordance with the provisions of the Constitution; and

**WHEREAS**, with the merging of the LAA International and Domestic bases on May 2, 2015 the size of the APFA BOD has been reduced from 20 to 14 current members and will be further reduced with the combining of DCA LUS & LAA to 13 members; and

**WHEREAS**, the bi-monthly EC/BOD Briefing calls, that were officially established in October 2015, provide the BOD the additional ability to communicate, to identify shared interests and/or concerns, and to manage and/ direct the affairs of the APFA, and

**WHEREAS**, the APFA Constitution was amended on September 21, 1991, which added the position and duties of the Ad Hoc member of the Executive Committee, and

**WHEREAS**, with the reduced size of the BOD along with the new environment in which the APFA operates today, the necessity and/or structure of the Executive Committee must be reviewed with scrutiny.

**BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED,** the APFA Board of Directors recommends that a Constitution Review Committee (CRC) determine what changes need to be made to the APFA Constitution for the elimination of the Ad Hoc members of the Executive Committee.
