RE: Plotting Training for Draftees for Legacy American Airlines (LAA)

Dear Marcus:

This letter will confirm our understanding and agreement regarding the consent of LAA Flight Attendants to move Duty-Free Periods (DFPs) when drafted for training as provided for in Article 22.E.2.b.(1). Currently, the timeframe for determining which, if any, Flight Attendants will be drafted for a particular training and when the training is actually placed on their schedule does not allow a Flight Attendant sufficient time to provide the Company with notice of consent to move a DFP(s). This can lead to an undesirable and unpaid trip removal for training. To help avoid these undesirable trip removals while still preserving a Flight Attendant's ability to retain her/his original DFPs, the following procedures will become effective with the contractual month of March 2016:

- 1. The Company will continue to plot training on Days Off (DOs) for drafted Flight Attendants.
- 2. If there are no classes available on DOs, the Company will have the ability to move DFPs to plot training.
 - If the Flight Attendant did not choose to consent to move her/his DFPs, s/he can
 contact the Company to reschedule the training to a class which does not require
 a DFP to be moved. This may result in an unpaid removal from a trip that was
 part of her/his original schedule. The Flight Attendant must contact the Company
 to be rescheduled as soon as possible, but no later than the first day of the
 contractual month.
- 3. If there are no classes available to plot using 1 and 2 above, the Company may remove a trip, unpaid, for the purpose of plotting training.

This agreement will apply to all training which is proffered post bid-run and results in drafting and will remain in effect until implementation of the Training Bidding System (TBS) in the AA/APFA Joint Collective Bargaining Agreement.



It is understood that the provisions of the AA/APFA Collective Bargaining Agreement, except as specifically modified or excepted by this letter, shall apply in all respects.
