WHEREAS, the APFA Board of Directors is the governing body of the union; and

WHEREAS, the APFA Constitution shall be the supreme law of the land of the APFA; and

WHEREAS, the APFA Constitution, Article I Section 4 "Office Locations", shall be determined by the Board of Directors and shall only be changed by a two- thirds (2/3) majority of the Voting Board of Directors; and

WHEREAS, APFA is taking steps to be fiduciarily responsible; and

WHEREAS, the base of Philadelphia (PHL) is the only base with a separate office to conduct APFA business; and

WHEREAS, obtaining this Philadelphia (PHL) offsite office is maintained by the PHL budget and falls within the constraints of said budget; and

WHEREAS, it is an unnecessary expenditure of approximately \$14,400 annually to APFA; and

**WHEREAS**, the APFA Board of Directors is in violation of The APFA Constitution, Article I Section 4 "Office Locations", and

WHEREAS, the APFA Board of Directors has never authorized the Philadelphia Base Office, via two-thirds (2/3) vote, consistent with The APFA Constitution, Article I Section 4 "Office Locations", and

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Philadelphia base office shall be closed immediately; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, no other field/base offices will be leased from this point forward; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, the savings from the closure of the Philadelphia Base office shall be added back to the PHL Base budget.
