WHEREAS, the APFA Board of Directors is the governing body of the APFA; and

**WHEREAS**, Article III, Section 3.A. "authorizes and empowers the APFA Board of Directors to take any and all lawful action consistent with the Constitution to safeguard and protect the APFA, and the rights, privileges, duties and responsibilities of the officers, representatives and members of the APFA. The Board of Directors is authorized to interpret the Constitution and to establish, prescribe and adopt

such other policies which may be consistent with this Constitution as required for the direction and management of the affairs of the APFA;" and

WHEREAS, Resolution #2 was passed at August 26, 2019, a Special Meeting of the APFA Board of Directors; and

WHEREAS, on September 4, 2019, a letter was sent to the 3 former National Officers named in this resolution providing formal notice that the BOD had passed Resolution #2 at the August 26, 2019 Special BOD Meeting demanding that over-payment be recovered and APFA be made whole; and

**WHEREAS**, on September 18, 2019, a 2<sup>nd</sup> letter was sent to the 3 former National Officers named in this resolution, providing the auditor's calculation of the incorrect payout amounts including calculations for each specific former Officer and demanding repayment within 10 days of the receipt of such letter; and

**WHEREAS**, the 3 former Officers named in this resolution contacted the Base Presidents directly, demanding a review of documentations, a copy of the RLI Insurance Policy, and a meeting to review how the amounts were calculated; and

WHEREAS, the Base Presidents granted an extension for repayment based on this request; and

**WHEREAS**, on October 30, 2019, the 3 former Officers named in this resolution met with the APFA Treasurer, Legal Counsel, and the APFA Independent Auditor and did in fact review documentation to substantiate amounts and calculations; and

WHEREAS, the 3 former Officers calculated these payouts and made payment to themselves prior to the end of their term, yet continue to make unreasonable demands of the APFA; and

**WHEREAS**, on November 8, 2019, a  $3^{rd}$  letter was sent to the former Officers demanding immediate payment; and

**WHEREAS**, to date no payment has been received, nor have they made attempt to set up a payment plan with the APFA;

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**; if payment is not received or no payment plan is in place within 14 days of this resolution, APFA BOD will move forward with administrative action to recoup these over-payments.
