WHEREAS, the Coronavirus crisis has caused APFA leadership to find ways to continue to serve the membership during quarantines, travel bans, and safe and social distancing mandates; and

WHEREAS, APFA continues to utilize the use of technology to successfully serve the membership at a significant cost savings by reducing and eliminating travel expenses; and

WHEREAS, the APFA Policy Manual authorizes reimbursement for cellular telephone and broadband (internet) service for Base Presidents, Base Vice Presidents, Executive Committee members, Department Chairs, APFA Specialists, Regional Representatives, and Live Chat Representatives; and

WHEREAS, we have APFA members serving in various positions such as but not limited to Headquarters' Department Representatives; and

WHEREAS, these individuals provide services to our membership both locally and nationally; and

WHEREAS, they rely on the use of cellular telephone and internet service to perform and accomplish their duties.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, that Section 5.G.1.e (1)(g)[1] be amended to include new paragraph:

5.G.1.e(1)(g)[1](b) Headquarters' Department Representative (on a full month trip removal that work a Majority of their shifts remotely) may be reimbursed cellular telephone expenses not to exceed forty-five dollars (\$45) per month.

and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Section 5.G.1.e (1)(b)[7] be amended to include new paragraph:

5.G.1.e (1)(b)[7](b): A Headquarters' Department Representative (on a full month trip removal), (that works a majority of their shifts remotely) may be reimbursed for up to fifty dollars (\$50) of the monthly cost applied to one of the following types of broadband: DSL, cable, fiber or satellite.
