WHEREAS, Ron Harris has continued to assist in the APFA Retirement Department in the last two years as well as founding Facebook Groups to answer the myriad of questions and concerns from Flight Attendants who were faced with whether or not to retire in the midst of the COVID-19 Pandemic.
