In 2021, the Association of Professional Flight Attendants ("APFA") filed and submitted to the System Board of Adjustment ("System Board") various Individual, Group and Base disputes protesting American Airlines' ("Company") violations of the Joint Collective Bargaining Agreement ("JCBA") related to carry-over sequences.

In accordance with JCBA Section 31.K.1.f.ii, the APFA hereby provides notice to the Company that APFA elects to convert the following Individual, Group and Base disputes related to carry-over sequences to a Presidential Grievance:

Pursuant to JCBA Section 31.K.1.f.ii, within forty-five (45) days of notice of conversion, the grievance must be scheduled for a pre-arbitration conference. Should the Company desire to file
