Cabin Air Quality SOF Checklist

- 1. **IDENTIFY** quickly where the odor is coming from (air vents, galley, oven, Lav, row). If no passengers are onboard, step off the airplane for fresh air.
- 2. **NOTIFY** pilots with
 - Where the odor is.
 (air vents, fwd, mid, aft, galley, row, oven, lav)
 - What the odor smells like.
 (musty, dirty, chemical, burning, rotten)
 - When it became noticeable.
 (gate, taxi, climb, cruise, descent, arrival)
 - Why are you concerned.
 - o (symptoms, passenger complaint, visual concern)
- ADVISE by contacting the IOC at 682-315-7070.
 Let them know if you are experiencing symptoms consistent with air contamination, inhalation, exposure, or injury along with Flight # and where the event occurred.
- 4. SEEK immediate medical treatment if you have symptoms at the nearest hospital at a hospital equipped to administer an arterial blood draw to detect carbon monoxide exposure, administer oxygen for respiratory effects, take your vitals, and do a neurological test, and follow-up visits by a physician,
- 5. INFORM the hospital at check-in, you need to be seen immediately for exposure by inhalation to toxic chemicals in engine oil/hydraulic fluid/deicing fluid leaking in through the air circulation system of the airplane. - 7. DOCUMENT the event with a CERS report under the topic of 'Fire/Smoke/Fumes/Odor' and with a Cabin ASAP (Aviation Safety Action Program) Report under 'General or Specific Cabin Safety Concern > Fire/ Smoke/ Odor.'
